3. Matters Arising from Previous Minutes (Not discussed at meeting)

- 3.1 LM also stated at the last meeting that England Netball have £7000 to put into West Yorkshire for 2006-2007. PH/LM & Nigel Harrison have now discussed how this money is best spent alongside any other monies received.
- 3.2 It was decided that all monies will be passed over to WYCNA and as with previous years the County Management Group and it's various sub-groups will steer the plan. PH would like to put £2000 back into West Yorkshire Sport in order to 'buy' into the new WYS structure. The £2000 will provide:
- This translates to 2.5 hours of officer time a week (Based on £30,000 for a full time officer – including on costs etc)
 - Administration Support for the Development Group Meetings. An officer will attend these meetings and administrate them.
 - Assistance with the writing up of development plans]

- Provide a contact for the sport at the WYS team.
- Where appropriate attend regional meetings.
- Access to any of the skills offered by the officers at West Yorkshire Sport as follows
 - Communications and Events Officer
 - Performance Measurement Expertise
 - Equity Expertise
- Promote any news on our website and weekly email
- Receive our weekly email
- Information on courses and conferences

4. Year 3 Plan.

- 4.1 LM requested that all monitoring information (copies of registers) need to be sent to LM **ASAP**

5. Year 4 Plan - Priorities

- 5.1 The group went through the 2005-2006 (year 3 plan) and set the priorities and targets for 2006-2007 (see attached). This plan would feed into the Larger WY Netball Plan.

6. WY Junior League

- 6.1 All fed back that the league is running very well and all participants are enjoying it
- 6.2 RP questioned who would be running the league when LM's post changes. LM confirmed that she will run the league as a volunteer from 1st April 2006.
- 6.3 LM informed the group that an umpire has highlighted some 'inappropriate' behaviour amongst some of the girls. LM requested that all coaches go back to their clubs and instil the appropriate codes of conduct to the juniors.
- 6.4 Issues around players playing up and down were discussed. It was agreed that if a player is good enough to play up then they should stay with that team.
- 6.5 Discussions took place around age groups for next year. It was highlighted that despite the fact it was agreed that 16 year olds should be playing in senior teams instead of the WY Junior League teams, not all 16 year olds have the skills to be selected for the senior teams.

6.6 All clubs to gauge age make up of juniors they would like to play in the WYJNL before next meeting. This will help decide the age brackets for next season.

6.7 LM outlined that due to the fact the league will be run voluntarily, all match fee cheques received after March 31st must be made payable to **West Yorkshire County Netball Association** NOT Kirklees MC.
